Members of the Rutgers University Community:

I am pleased to announce the selection of two outstanding individuals to spearhead the search for the 20th president of Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey.

Greg Brown will serve as chairman of the Presidential Search Committee; Linda Stamato will serve as vice chair. These appointments were made based on recommendations received from the university community. They also adhere to the criteria of having someone from within the university and someone external to Rutgers but with strong ties to the institution assume these pivotal roles.

Greg Brown is chairman and chief executive officer of Motorola Solutions, Inc. He previously served as CEO as well as president and chief operating officer of Motorola, Inc.; chairman and CEO of Micromuse Inc.; and president of Ameritech Custom Business Services and Ameritech New Media Inc. An active member of the civic and business communities, he recently was appointed by President Obama to the President's Management Advisory Board as well as to the Skills for America's Future board. He received his bachelor's degree from Rutgers in 1982 and is a member of Rutgers' Board of Trustees and Board of Overseers.

Linda Stamato is a member of the graduate faculty and codirector of Rutgers' Center for Negotiation and Conflict Resolution at the Edward J. Bloustein School of Planning and Public Policy. The author of numerous articles on mediation, she served twice on the New Jersey State Board of Higher Education; was a member of the Commission on Higher Education of the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools; and served as a trustee at Montclair State University and The College of New Jersey. She holds bachelor's and master's degrees from Rutgers and was acting dean of Douglass College from 2001 to 2002. Chair of the Rutgers Board of Governors from 1981 to 1984, she has also served on the Rutgers Board of Trustees and several important university committees.

The Presidential Search Committee is charged with identifying and screening candidates and presenting to the Board of Governors the names of at least five nominees who best embody the preferred characteristics of the president of Rutgers. The university community will have

opportunities to recommend attributes and qualifications desired in the next president and submit names for consideration. Further information can be found on the Presidential Search website: presidentalsearch.rutgers.edu.
